

## What makes an ideal herbicide for wheat this autumn ?

### Summary

Use Digital this autumn to boost your grass-weed control !

- Does it will fit well into your weed control programmes this autumn ?	<b>Digital does.</b>
- Is it an easy-to-use low application rate liquid formulation which makes it an ideal product for the spray operator ?	<b>Digital is.</b>

### BLACK-GRASS Pre-emergence

Digital is an ideal product to contribute to the residual stacking approach which can be mixed with other relevant herbicides such as Liberator, Defy, or chlorotoluron-based products. It will contribute significantly to the defence against black-grass as well as adding it's extremely wide broad-leaf weed spectrum.

*What level of control will Digital contribute at this timing ? About 30 - 40% although higher levels of control have often been seen in trials. In a residual stack Digital will boost your pre-em black-grass control by an additional 20-25%.*



### BLACK-GRASS Post-emergence

Digital can be used alone or in mix with Liberator or chlorotoluron-based products. (Do not mix with Defy at this timing). Target grass-weeds when small, up to 1-2 leaf. Broad-leaf weeds can be 2-4 leaves. Crops need to be reasonably hardy which should be the normal situation at this time of year.

*What level of control will Digital contribute at this timing ? 40-60% black-grass control.*



### Broad-leaf weed control

Digital has an enviable broad-leaf weed spectrum, either pre- or post-emergence. This makes flumioxazin the ideal partner for autumn programmes. As well as the extensive list of weeds on the label, flumioxazin is reported to be excellent post-em on volunteer beans, borage and a range of other less common autumn germinating species.

*Does it control poppies, charlock, groundsel, mayweed, cleavers, speedwells ? Yes. Read the label and the Autumn 2010 leaflet for a full spectrum, or ring Interfarm.*



*What about Annual Meadow-grass? Flumioxazin offers excellent control of annual meadow-grass, which coupled with its broad-leaf weed activity means it's the ideal autumn product alone for medium AMG areas. The addition of 0.1L/ha Liberator or a low dose CTU will maximise its activity if there is a high AMG population.*



### What are the DO's and DO NOT's ?

Do start and finish spraying with a clean tank. You might be surprised about the amount of residue left in a spray tank from a previous task even after flushing with water

Do not mix with pendimethalin products, either pre or post-emergence for reason of crop safety.

Do not mix with adjuvants or highly wetted products for the same reason
