

Disease Control in Oilseed Rape this autumn

• Beware Downy Mildew and Phoma

There are two disease problems facing oilseed rape growers this autumn - downy mildew and Phoma. Crops are in a variety of growth stages from cotyledon to multi-leafed. Given the stress and late development of many crops, protection from disease should be a key autumn crop management task.

Summary

Downy mildew Well-established plants can often shrug off infections but backward plants at this time of year need help.

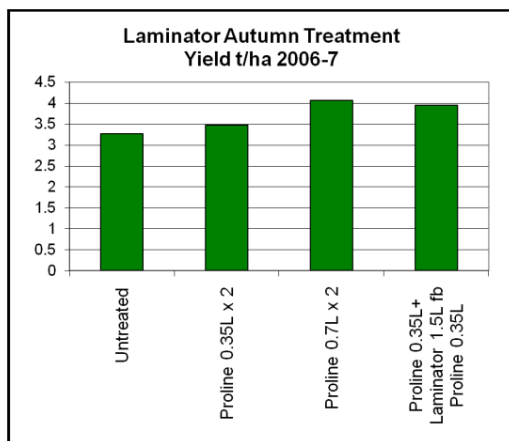
