

T-0 Management in Winter Wheat - “Quell” any potential disease infections

It really makes sense to get on with T0 applications as soon as possible. With spring slowly arriving, there are a huge number of jobs to do on farm and if there are any further weather interruptions, T1 sprays will get delayed, leading to increased disease cycling and inoculum build-up. Applying a T0 spray will give control from the start of your wheat fungicide programme, allowing you to concentrate on other urgent tasks. This is particularly relevant if early disease infection is present or suspected.

Summary

It is important to use **Quell Flo** at T0 as soon as possible in order to gain control of wheat disease management programmes. **Quell Flo** is an ideal choice for a T0 fungicide spray for a wide variety of reasons.
